Background

- Raised at Safety and Reliability Symposium October, 2011
- Need for a mechanism to exchange knowledge relating to Reliability within surface mining community
- Smaller, more frequent, opportunities to meet
- Expressed need for on-line information exchange

- Operator –driven
- No overlap with other groups; collaborate
- US and Canadian participation
- Minimum organizational overhead, cost
